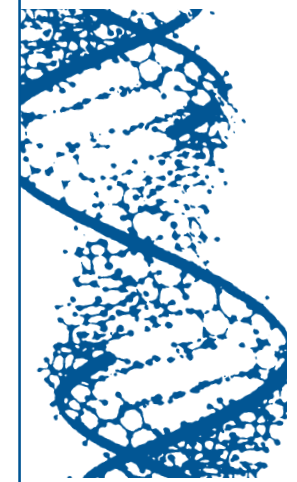

WHAT IS MISPP?

The New York State **Medical Information Services Program (MISP)** is designed to assist libraries of all types in helping **New York residents** obtain the medical information they need by subsidizing document delivery.

WHEN WOULD I USE IT?

When a patron requests medical or healthcare information resources (journal articles, reports, etc.) not available locally, but identified in PubMed® or other databases, **MISP** subsidizes the document delivery fees charged by libraries in the National Network of Libraries of Medicine. Requests should be related to patient care, consumer health, research in medicine, or the education of health practitioners.

MISP comes into play when you need to go **beyond the usual local or system borrowing arrangements**.

There are no fees for the library or the patron. All categories of users qualify: students, health care consumers, health care professionals, and researchers.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

MISP subsidizes libraries for costs related to fulfilling patron requests for medical information **when supplied through interlibrary loan**. **MISP** requests are filled by medical libraries in the region, in the state, throughout the country, or globally.
