# **Hospital Libraries**

The Hospital Library Services Program (HLSP) allows SENYLRC's hospital librarians the opportunity to work collaboratively to enhance services and meet increasing demands for peer-reviewed literature. HLSP also provides access to a federated search system for one-stop searching for all electronic resources, reduced vendor pricing, and cost savings thanks to a SENYLRCadministered state subsidy.

The Medical Information Services Program (MISP) subsidizes the delivery of peer-reviewed medical information to all types of libraries in the region, including hospital, public, school, and academic libraries.
